Education and Pre-Requisites

Applicant Requirements

- Must be 21 years of age
- Must be in good physical condition
- Must be able to consistently lift 80 pounds
- Must be comfortable on ladders
- Must be able to work in all weather conditions
- Must be fluent in English (both written and verbal)
- Must provide your own health insurance
- Must have a current Drivers license and vehicle.
- Must be able to follow directions and work in a team environment

Preference will be given to Candidates with at least one year of undergraduate program studies in zoology, biology, or other animal-related fields as well as previous construction work.

Compensation and Benefits

Internships are non-paid positions and run for approximately 30 weeks. Interns work five days a week with a minimum of 35 hours including both week-day and weekends as needed. There is no on-site housing so you must be local or have a place to live. There is no public transport so you must have a vehicle. We do provide a \$100 stipend each week to help with gas.

Interns who complete their program have the first opportunity for a full-time job when posted.
