

Shelter Farm Sanctuary is the Second Farm Sanctuary in Florida to be Accredited by the Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries



April 28, 2022 (Arcadia, FL) – The Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries (GFAS), the only globally recognized organization providing standards for identifying legitimate animal sanctuaries, awarded Accredited status to Shelter Farm Sanctuary as of April 19, 2022.

Accreditation signifies that Shelter Farm Sanctuary meets GFAS' rigorous and peer-reviewed animal care standards which are confirmed by a comprehensive site visit. Accreditation also signifies adherence to standards addressing the sustainability of the organization, ethical principles, finances, staffing, education, outreach, security and safety and other operational aspects. The Accreditation status also provides a clear and trusted means for the public, donors, and grantors to recognize Shelter Farm Sanctuary as an exceptional organization.
